Lesson 8.2: Obsession

SCRIPTURE READING

Acts 4:1-31

SUMMARY:

Most things people obsess over are trivial and meaningless in the grand scheme of life. But what does it mean to be obsessed with the gospel? Acts 4 begins with Peter and John being arrested for performing miracles and warned to stop preaching in Jesus' name. But did they listen? Of course not! Peter and John responded to the religious leaders' warning by saying it is more important to listen to God than to men.

These men were truly obsessed with Christ. That is the power of the gospel. As witnesses for Christ, we have the truth and so we need to share it with others. And think about how this all started with just two men, Peter and John. Their obsession for spreading the gospel became contagious and affected the entire believing community.
