

**FACILITATION HELP: CONFLICT RESOLUTION**

It may be a simple difference of opinion or something much more serious, but you can help them work through their differences. Don't let conflict go unattended within your group. Any conflict will taint your group and create an unsafe environment for sharing, not only for those involved in the conflict, but everyone else too. Talk to your students and help them resolve their conflicts. Be careful not to attempt to handle situations beyond your ability. Involve your director, pastor, and the students' parents as necessary and appropriate. First and foremost is the safety of all of your students.
