

FACILITATION HELP: PRIME THE PUMPS

If you have an older lawn mower, weed whacker, or snowblower, you probably need to prime the pump. There is a little red button that injects fuel into the engine so that it can turn over when you go to pull the cord. Sometimes our students need their engines or their brains to be primed. You might want to think about injecting one or two questions into their minds before you meet with your group. If you students are plugged into technology, then send them a text with one or two questions for them to think about prior to coming to group. Give them time and space to process rather than just blindsiding them with deeper questions.
