# FACILITATION HELP: ENGAGING INTROVERTS

Our desire is to engage every student with the Bible and small group discussion. For some students that's easier to gauge than others. The amount of contributions to a group discussion is, alone, not a good indicator of how engaged a student is in the Bible study. Intentionally engage introverts in ways that honor their quiet nature. Every once in a while, instead of asking students to share with the entire group, ask students to pair up and share with one other person. Let volunteers share what they learned with the entire group later. Also, encourage and facilitate without pressuring everyone in the group to share his or her thoughts. Both of these things create a comfortable environment for introverts to grow and learn. Assess their engagement through personal conversation with them before and after group, not by putting them on the spot.
