## FACILITATION HELP: TELL YOUR STORY

Use the messes and successes of your life to teach and mentor these impressionable young people. As they look to you for advice and guidance, tell stories of how you've made decisions and the consequences or impact those decisions had on your life. Whether your story shows your wisdom or immaturity, it is an incredible way to connect with students and leave a lasting impression on them. And hopefully it will help them make wise decisions for themselves.
