## **FACILITATION HELP:**

Maybe your group doesn't have any problems with your group discussion. Lucky you! However, when working with this age, giving everyone a chance to speak can be a challenge, especially when you have some very dominant personalities in the group. Find something that you can pass around. It could be a ball, an empty soda bottle, a pillow, etc. Whoever has this item in their hands can talk while everyone else must listen. This is a simple technique but might be just the thing to bring some order to the group discussion. It's important for everyone to have a chance to speak. Often we just hear the loud kids in our group, but the deepest thinkers tend to be the ones who say very little most of the time. Give everyone a chance to speak up and be heard.
